

DEKALB COUNTY
2009 APPROVED PRECINCT CHANGES

The DeKalb County Board of Registration and Elections has submitted the following precinct boundary changes that will be effective upon approval by the Department of Justice:

- Relocation from Lithonia Middle School to Union Missionary Baptist Church to vacate temporary emergency location (No Board of Commissioners approval required for non-boundary change.)
- Approved by the Board of Commissioners on June 23, 2009: Relocation from Community Bible Chapel to McNair High School to facilitate voter growth in area.
- Approved by the Board of Commissioners on August 11, 2009:
 - Relocation of McNair Middle School to McNair Academy to make McNair Middle available for voters displaced by three school closings
 - Relocation of Forrest Hills Elementary School and a portion of Hooper Alexander Elementary School to Avondale High School because of the closing of Forrest Hills and Hooper Alexander
 - Relocation of a portion of Hooper Alexander Elementary School to Candler precinct because of the closing of Hooper Alexander
 - Relocation of Tilson Elementary School and a portion of Kelley Lake Elementary School to McNair Middle because of the closing of Tilson and congestion at Kelley Lake
